Being connected to the people we love is critical to our emotional and physical well-being. Many people experiencing our services are sick from loneliness. It's not about more money...we need to think and behave in different ways!

Paradigm and **David Pitonyak** invite you to this conference to learn, share, and shape ideas for moving beyond interventions and coverage to approaches that support enduring, freely chosen relationships.

This conference is part of Paradigm's work to support people to lead good ordinary lives.

Sally Warren (MD Paradigm) explains:

"Loneliness, isolation, a sense of looking 'in from the outside'.... are all emotions and experiences people talk to us about on a regular basis. People talk of "A life in service land. A life of rules to 'protect'". Few people truly listen and respond to this deep loneliness."



The conference explores:

- The impact of loneliness in the lives of people who have learning disabilities
- The importance of going home to the people we love not people who provide coverage
- Strategies for helping people reduce their loneliness and connect more with other people
- Ways to identify people's needs and how loneliness can impact on people's behaviour



What will you gain from the workshop?

- Strategies for helping people who are lonely to develop enduring, freely chosen, positive relationships
- Problem-solving strategies for times when relationships are unbalanced or slow in developing
- A better understanding of how loneliness and isolation affects people with learning disabilities and how this might be shown in their behaviour
- A better understanding and knowledge of people's behaviours and how to identify them
